ANNUAL CONFERENCE FEATURES "THE CONSCIENCE OF PSYCHIATRY:" DR. PETER BREGGIN

Dr. Breggin's keynote presentation on September 8, is entitled: "Drug – Free Therapy for Adults and Children, including ADHD." He has published more than 40 peer-reviewed articles and more than 20 books including the best seller: *Talking Back to Prosac*.

We will depart from our typical Saturday format in that Dr. Breggin will be the sole presenter from 9:15 a.m. until 11:15 a.m. At 11:30 Dr. Breggin will take questions until 12:45 p.m., while three additional 75 minute presentations will be offered concurrently. In the afternoon there will be two 75 minute blocks with six presentations in Block 3 and five presentations in Block 4.

We have been able to attract six top presenters to offer workshops all day Friday and six additional excellent presenters to offer workshops from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. Sunday.

Our presenters are coming from ten states, Canada, Jamaica, and Romania.

The conference brochure will be sent to members of SCSAP and NASAP within 10 days and we expect to have the registration brochure available on the SCSAP web site for on-line registration by July 20.

A complimentary hospitality evening will be held Friday evening, while Saturday will include hors d'oeuvres and cash bar at 5:00 p.m. with a sing-a-long, and line dancing at pool side later in the evening.
